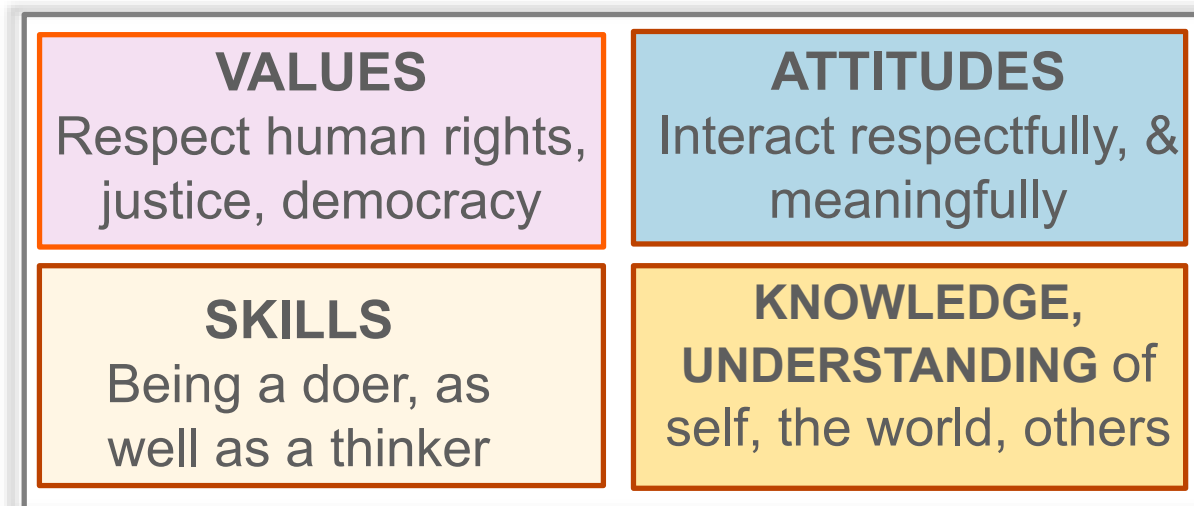

Why is digital citizenship education important?

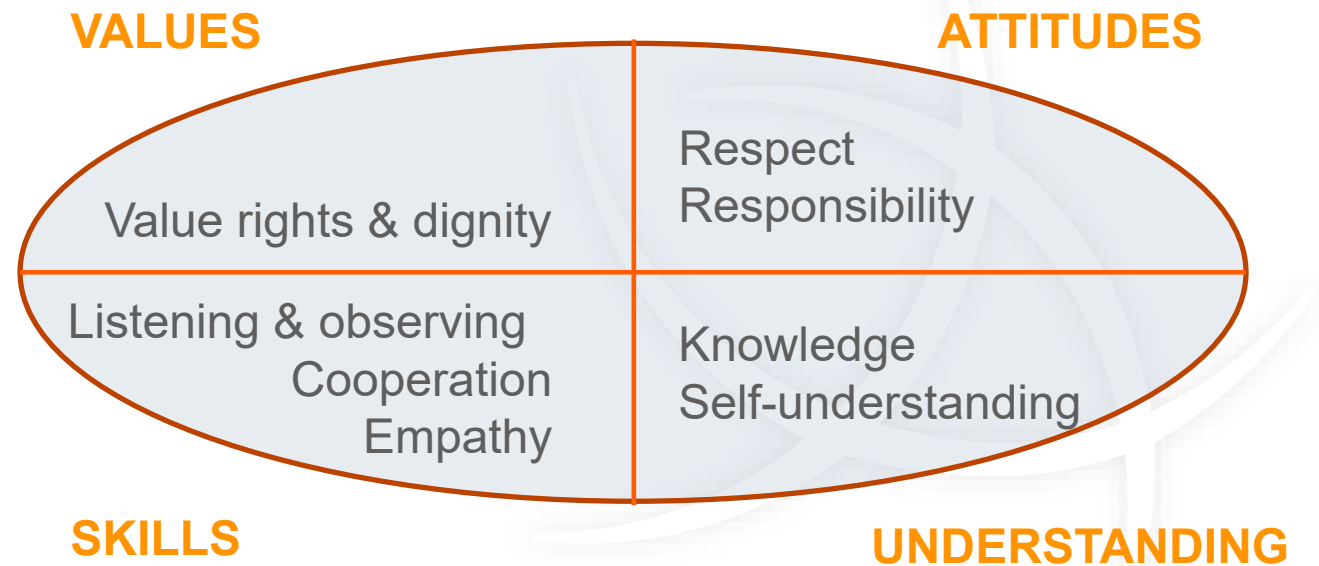


Digital citizenship provides children with a set of competences that help them become:

- more responsible about what they do online;
- more resilient to the challenges of the virtual world;
- more adaptable, open to different views, cultures, practices.



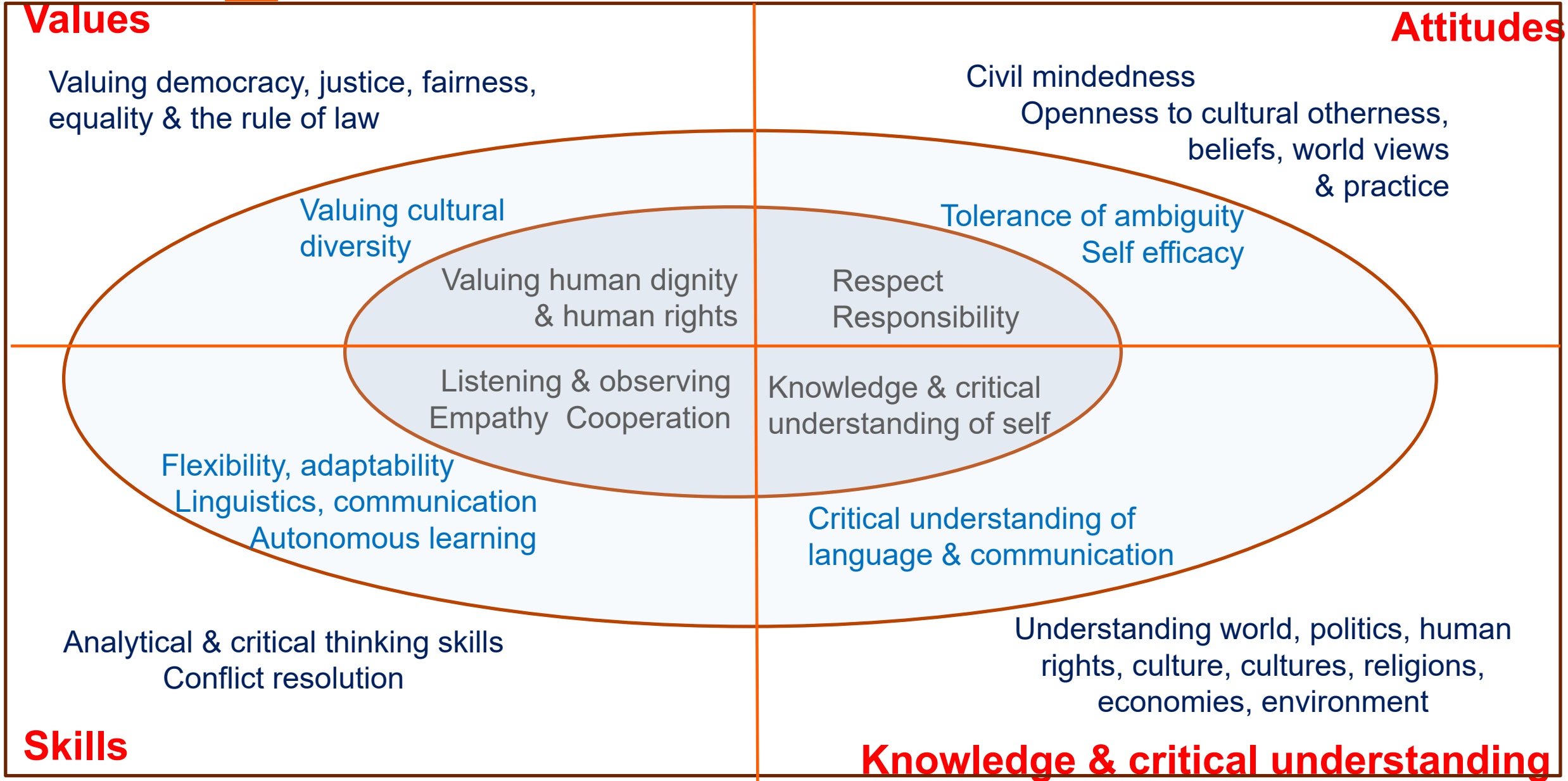
DCE – an ongoing process that begins in the cradle



Reference Framework for a Democratic Culture

20 competences for a Democratic Culture.

 = early childhood  = middle childhood



Only 1 in 3 parents say they understand what it means to be a digital citizen

Less than 40% talk to their children about behaving respectfully & kindly online

50 -70% OF PARENTS USE TECH WITH THEIR CHILDREN to watch videos, communicate with family, do homework.

1 in 10 create content with their children

1 in 5 show them how to use social networks

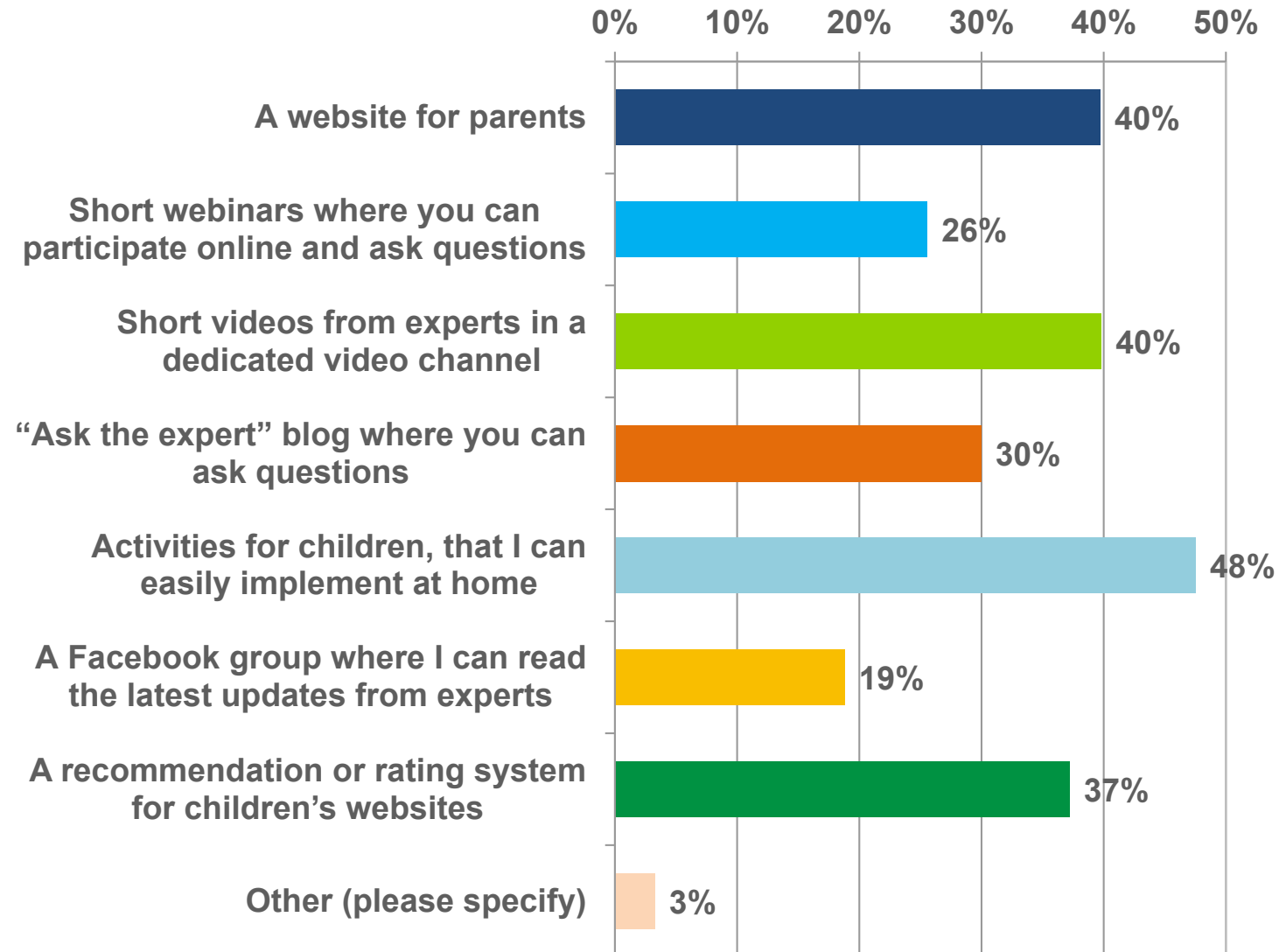


Less than 50% of parents say they know their children's online friends

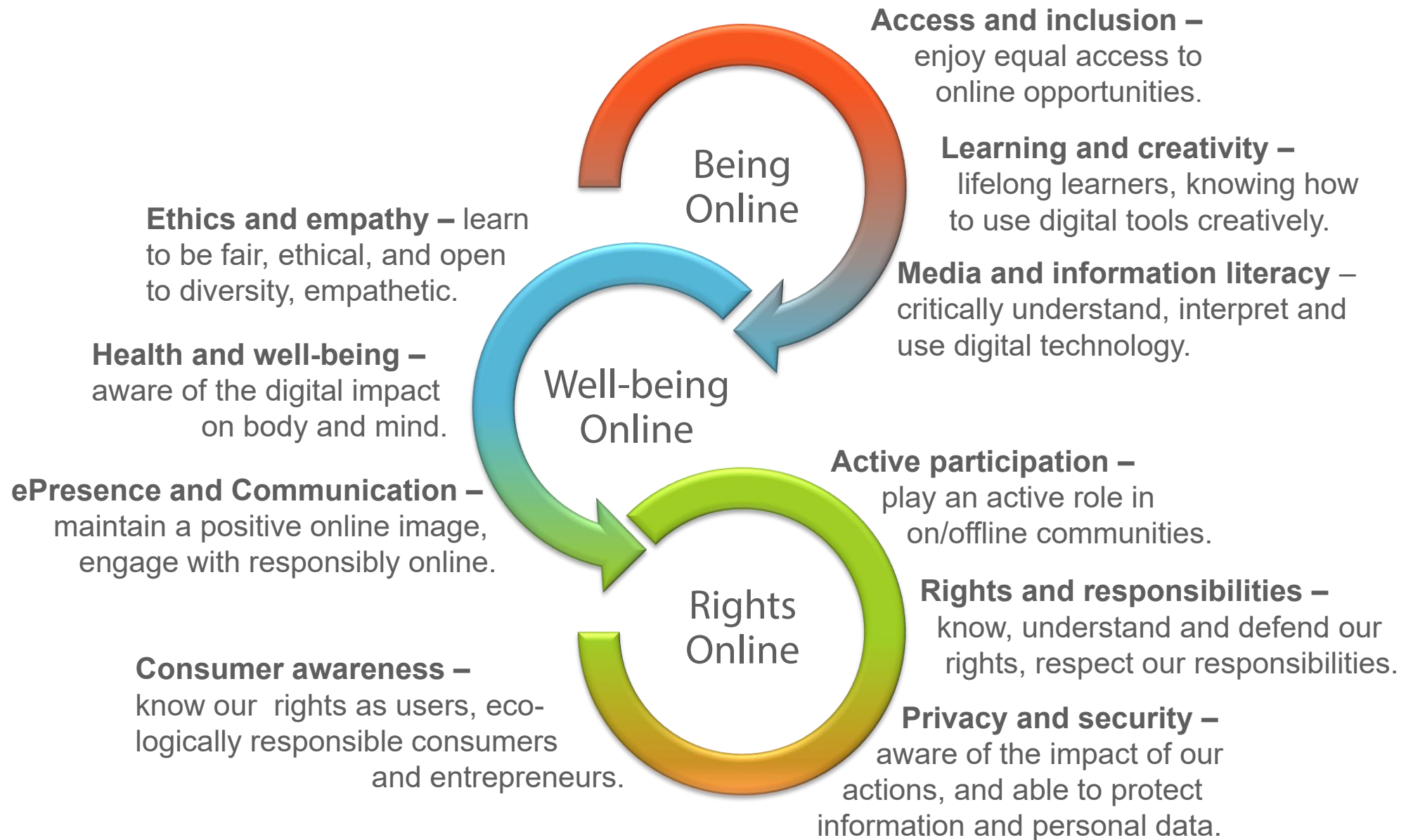
75% of parents talk to their children about bullying

Etika in empatija

Otroci z duševnimi in telesnimi težavami imajo enake pravice kot drugi otroci do dostojanstva, samozavestnosti in aktivnega sodelovanja v skupnostih na spletu in zunaj njega.

- 👍 Naučite svoje otroke, naj bodo odprti za raznolikost.
- 👍 Z njimi poiščite v spletu primere podpornih tehnologij in aplikacij, ki pomagajo otrokom premagati invalidnost in izboljšati njihovo kakovost življenja.

e-prisotnost in komunikacije

Otroci imajo pravico do zaščite pred vsemi oblikami fizičnega in duševnega nasilja in trpinčenja ter kakršno koli obliko izkoriščanja, ki bi lahko ogrozila njihovo zdravje ali blaginjo.

- 👍 Razvijanje zaspunanja vrednega odnosa z otroki jih bo spodbudilo, da vam zaspajajo, ko gre kaj narobe. Z vami kot varnostno mrežo, bodo zgradili odpornost in se lahko poberejo po boleči izkušnji (kot je ustrahovanje).

e-prisotnost in komunikacije

Otroci imajo pravico do zaščite pred napadi na njihovo dobro počutje in ugled.

- 👍 Pogovorite se s svojimi otroki o etični in odgovorni uporabi interneta ter o uporabi enakih pravil lepega vedenja na spletu in zunaj njega.
- 👍 Opomnite jih, da vse, kar počnejo na spletu, pušča digitalni odtis, ki bo pomagal oblikovati njihov ugled in morda prihodnost.
